Contributions

Contribution rates will be based on income and assets and vary by the amount and types of service received. An income and asset assessment similar to the Aged Pension Means Test will be used by Services Australia to determine the contribution rate. The 'no worse off principle' applies to anyone who was receiving a Home

Care Package or approved for a package on 12 September 2024, which means a contribution the same, or lower, than what was charged through the Home Care Package program. The contribution will be set as a percentage of the price of each service received, as indicated in the table below.
